What You Can Expect in Our Therapeutic Literacy Program

We're so glad you're here. At the Willamette Valley Dyslexia Center, your child receives top-tier, research-aligned literacy intervention using Orton-Gillingham methodology and our proprietary curriculum, Decoded.

This is not homework help. This is therapy for reading, designed to create real, measurable change.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

- **Consistent Schedule**

Your child receives a dedicated tutoring time on the same days each week. Consistency = progress.

- **The Same Tutor Every Session**

We believe in relationship-based learning. Your child will work with the same trained interventionist every session, barring illness or emergencies.

- **Structured, Evidence-Based Instruction**

We use Orton-Gillingham (OG) and the Science of Reading, delivered through the Decoded curriculum.

Instruction is:

- Sequential
- Cumulative
- Multisensory
- Diagnostic and responsive

This is the gold standard for dyslexia and reading intervention.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

Most families see:

Every child is different — but steady growth is expected.

- Progress Monitoring Three Times Per Year: We reassess in fall, winter, and spring to: Measure growth, Adjust goals, Share clear updates with families & Celebrate progress together
- Make-Ups are offered when we cancel. If WVDC must cancel a session (sickness, emergencies, weather closures), we do our best to offer a make-up.
- We do not offer credits or refunds, because your tuition pays for more than the minutes in a session — it secures your child's spot in our program.

WHAT YOUR TUITION PAYS FOR

Your monthly tuition secures your child's reserved tutoring time slot, plus all of the support wrapped around each session:

- Trained, OG-aligned interventionist
- Customized lesson planning
- Data collection + progress monitoring
- Curricular materials (Decoded)
- All communication with families
- Ongoing professional training for your tutor
- Your child's space in our schedule — even during weeks with closures

You are not paying "per session." You are investing in a seat in a therapeutic program that runs year-round.

FLAT-RATE BILLING EXPLAINED

We use flat-rate monthly billing to create stability for families and tutors. This means your monthly tuition already includes a built-in discount to account for our planned closures:

- Labor Day Week / back-to-school transition
- Thanksgiving week
- Christmas & New Year's holiday break
- Spring Break

Tuition does not increase during months with extra weeks, nor decrease during holidays.

This ensures predictable budgeting and consistent staffing – a cornerstone of therapeutic tutoring.

WHY THIS IS DIFFERENT FROM OTHER TUTORING

Many families come to us after trying “helpful” and/ or “expensive” but ineffective tutoring.

Traditional tutoring often offers:

- Homework help instead of intervention
- Inconsistent schedules
- Untrained tutors
- Minimal data
- Good intentions → low results

What we offer is fundamentally different.
